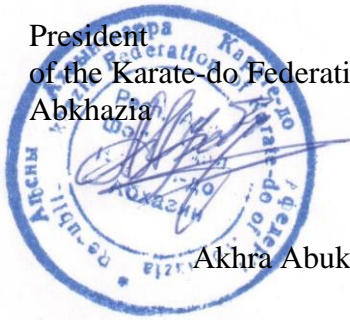

1 . INTRODUCTION

1.1. The International gathering, the Open Cup of Eurasia in Karate Do Shotokan Ryu Kase Ha (hereinafter – the Events), is held in 2021 on the basis of the decision of the Presidium of:

- a) The World Karate Union Do Shotokan Ryu Kase Ha (hereinafter-WKS KASE HA UNION);
- b) The Eurasian Karate Union Do Shotokan Ryu Kase Ha (hereinafter-EKS KASE HA UNION).

1.2. The tournament is held in accordance with the Rules of the WKS KASE HA UNION competition.

2. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE TOURNAMENT

2.1. The events are held in order to:

- a) promote and develop the physical culture and sports movement under the auspices of the World Karate Union Do Shotokan Ryu Kase Ha;
- b) strengthening the health of students and young people, forming a healthy lifestyle of the younger generation;
- c) improving the educational and training process and improving the skills of those engaged in karate-do Shotokan Ryu Kase Ha in schools and organizations;
- d) preparation of a reserve for national teams to participate in international events.

3. RIGHTS TO HOST THE TOURNAMENT

The World Karate Union Do Shotokan Ryu Kase Ha has the right to hold events. The event is directly held by the Karate-do Federation of Abkhazia.

7. REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPANTS

7.1. Teams of national and regional organizations of WKS KASE HA UNION are allowed to participate in the events.

7.2. Participants of the events must meet the qualification requirements, know the rules of the competition, take part in the international training camp and pass the admission commission.

7.3. Team representatives must have and submit to the admission commission for each athlete:

7.3.1. personal performances;

a) passport of the national organization;

b) a copy of the passport or birth certificate;

c) an official application, parental consent to participate in the competition, a coach's receipt (Appendices 1,2,3).

7.3.2. online performances (send by 20.06.2021 in electronic form by e-mail to kaseha@yandex.ru):

a) a copy of your passport or birth certificate;

b) video recording of one performance of a participant or team (front-end recording, no more than 25 MB.);

c) a photo or a scan of the payment receipt for participation.

8. THE COMPOSITION OF THE PARTICIPANTS OF THE COMPETITION

8.1. Participants of personal competitions are divided into age groups in accordance with the data given in Table 1.

8.2. The age of the participant is determined on 08.08.2021 by the date of birth indicated in the document with a stamped photo.

8.3. If there are not enough athletes (less than 4 people), it is possible to combine neighboring age categories or cancel them.

9. NUMERICAL COMPOSITIONS OF TEAMS

9.1. The delegation consists of:

a) athletes (in the form of: white karate gi with the WWW KASE HA UNION logo, a belt according to their technical qualifications on the official website, protective equipment according to the competition rules);

b) an official representative of the team according to the application (in the form of: tracksuit, sports shoes);

c) a trainer with a technical qualification is GIVEN, indicated on the official website of WWW KASE HA UNION (in the form of: tracksuit, sports shoes);

d) certified judges with the technical qualification of DAN, indicated on the official website of WWW KASE HA UNION (in the form of: dark trousers, white shirt with short sleeves, mustard-colored tie).

9.2. Each team is obliged to ensure the appearance and participation in the judging seminar and judging of at least one certified judge, otherwise penalties in the amount of **100 Dollars USA** are applied to it.

10. PROGRAM OF EVENTS

10.1. Arrival of teams and participants on August 05, 2021.

10.2. Schedule of work of the admission commission.

The Commission is open on August 06-07, 2021 from 17: 00 to 20: 00 at the venue of the events.

10.3. Procedure and terms of the draw

The electronic draw is held on the basis of preliminary applications in absentia.

11. SUMMING UP CONDITIONS

11.1. The competitions are held in accordance with the Rules of the World **Karate Union Do Shotokan Ryu Kase Ha** competitions.

11.2. The rules of the World Karate Union Do Shotokan Ryu Kase Ha competitions are posted on the following websites: www.kasehaworld.com, www.kaseha.ru, www.shotokan.com.mx

11.3. The competitions are held according to the system with elimination after defeat — the winner goes to the next round; the athletes who lost in the semifinals take the 3rd place.

12. AWARDING

12.1. Athletes and teams that took 1-3 places are awarded with medals and diplomas of the corresponding degrees. First and second places — one each in any type of competition program. There are two third places in the competition.

12.2. The results of the competitions are published by the Organizing Committee in the media

13. TERMS OF FINANCING

13.1. At the expense of the organizers, the costs of renting sports facilities, medical support, awarding participants, paying for refereeing and other expenses for the preparation and conduct of events are made.

13.2. At the expense of local budgets and extra-budgetary funds of sending organizations, cost items related to paying for the travel of participants (representatives, athletes, coaches and judges) to the venues of events,

as well as back, providing them with food, accommodation and maintaining wages are accepted for financing.

13.3. When submitting applications for participation in events, teams pay charitable contributions.

13.4. Charitable contributions for participation in events are determined in the amount of:

- participation in the one-day international training camp – **35 Dollars USA** per participant,
- participation in the two-day international training camp – **50 Dollars USA** per participant,
- participation in the technical exam-according to appendix No. 4,
- participation in the competition - **20 Dollars USA** for each personal type of program.

13.5. Charitable contributions for participation in online performances are sent to the organizing committee of events before the start of the work of the admission commission.

14. APPLICATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

14.1. Admission of participants is carried out by the admission commission.

14.2. The Commission works in accordance with the terms of these Regulations on August 07, 2021 from 17:00 to 20:00 at the venue of the events. The chairman of the commission is the chairman of the FKA Gennady Alekseevich Bartsits.

14.3. Preliminary applications are sent by August 01, 2021 by e-mail to kaseha@yandex.ru.

14.4. In the official application (Appendix 1), a general reduction in the number of participants is allowed.

14.5. The documents submitted to the commission for athletes of teams and judges are issued by the GSK to representatives of these teams with marks of participation in the competition after their completion, summing up and awarding.

15. PLACEMENT OF PARTICIPANTS

All issues related to booking, accommodation and accommodation, as well as visa and transport support, representatives and participants decide independently.
